Project 4

HTML & CSS Designer Resume

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Using your existing resume, you will be converting it to HTML and adding CSS to make it a designer resume.

PROJECT PARAMETERS:

- 1. Make a new folder in your CDN219 assignments folder and call it Project 4 HTML Resume.
- 2. Within this folder you might want to make a web folder for the HTML, images, and CSS of the page and an assets folder for everything that you might need but is not part of the page. For example, you would put into the assets folder your actual resume, the project sheet, and images that you may use in the site but need to adjust them first.
- 3. Within the web folder, create an images folder.
- 4. Open Brackets, then open the web folder of Project 4. Make sure you only see the images folder and nothing else.
- 5. Make a new document and save it as index.html.
- 6. Make another new document and save it as styles.css. Make sure to include the file extension.
- 7. You can copy and paste the beginning HTML codes or just type them in but do not forget about them.
- 8. Link the CSS page to your HTML page.
- 9. Make sure to use the CSS that we have learned to "design" your resume.
- 10. Codes must include:
 - HTML5 tags of header, section, and footer
 - At least 1 unique Google font
 - Background color or a background image for texture (do not include an image that has high contrast – the text must be readable)
 - Text color changes (at least 2)
 - h1 & h2 tags (could use more but at least have these two)
 - Horizontal Rule <hr /> tag (there are options for this look on D2L) or use border information in CSS to create lines and graphic elements
 - Social media icons at least LinkedIn and if you don't have one then you need to make one. You can link to me and your fellow students from class.
 - Skill Levels with your skills, you should include some sort of graphical system to indicate your skill level with the things you list in skills. Examples are on D2L.
- 11. Ideas for images that you may include on the page are: (not a necessity and do not plan to add all of these as that will clutter up the page)
 - Icon for software you plan to list in your skills
 - Logo design you create for your name or initials
 - Professional image of yourself
 - Logos for companies you have worked for

12. Save all files, zip the folder, rename the folder LastName_FirstInitial_Project4Resume.zip, and upload to appropriate dropbox.
